

Code of Conduct for Players

- Play Netball to enjoy yourself, and accept that striving to win is more important than winning itself. Victory and defeat are inevitable, and should be accepted equally.
- Understand and abide by the laws, rules and spirit of the game and any competition in which you participate.
- Players will exhibit good sportsmanship at all times, never condone violations of the laws of the game or exhibit behaviour contrary to the spirit of the laws of the game.
- Consistently display high standards of behaviour.
- Respect the umpires decisions at all times.
- Treat opponents with due respect at all times, and avoid words or actions that may mislead a match official.
- No offensive, abusive or insulting remarks shall be made toward any other player, official or parent.
- Encourage your teammates – you cannot win a game on your own.
- At the final whistle, shake hands with your opponents and the umpires.
