Travel is not included, this is up to you to organise, therefore you can choose to stay for five days or enhance and extend your stay to explore London and beyond at the weekends.



### Local Chiswick highlights



The wide boulevard like Chiswick High Road contains the main concentration of shops, cafés and restaurants, where tables spill out onto the pavement giving it a continental feel – perfect for people watching with a cup of coffee.

Take a stroll down the leafy Chiswick High Road where you'll find an array of artisan eateries and shops, with a 'village within a city' feel. The High Road also has many Grade II listed buildings, including pubs dating back to the 18th century.







Charming traditional pubs can be found on the banks of the Thames, where you can enjoy riverside views over a drink or two.

The local parks are some of the finest in West London – from the rustic beauty of Gunnersbury Triangle and riverside tranquility of Dukes Meadows Park to the landscaped gardens of Chiswick House.



### Getting around London

#### **Tube**

Two tube stations serve Chiswick – **Chiswick Park** on the District line, and **Turnham Green** on the District and Piccadilly lines.

You can reach Victoria in just over 20 minutes from Chiswick Park, and a train from Turnham Green will get you to Covent Garden in half an hour.

#### Rail

There's one railway station in Chiswick, with trains running regularly into the city. It'll take you less than half an hour to get to Waterloo, and around 50 minutes to get to Weybridge.

#### Bus

Five bus services operate in Chiswick, including the N9 night bus between the city and Heathrow Airport.

#### Road

The A4 passes through Chiswick where the M4 motorway begins, and Heathrow Airport is a 25 minute drive away.

### Cycle

You can cycle to Victoria in just over half an hour, with just three straight roads along the journey. You can also cycle in a segregated bike lane the length of Chiswick High Road.





### Location from London Airports









#### From Gatwick Airport 1hour

Catch an overground train to **London Victoria Station.** Change to the underground, take the **District Line** (green) and head west to Ealing
Broadway or Richmond (not Wimbledon).
Turnham Green is 10 stops.

1 hour by taxi / Uber.

### From Heathrow Airport 40 minutes

Take the underground **Piccadilly Line** (blue) and head east, nine stops to Acton Town. Change to **District Line** (green) and head east, 2 stops to Turnham Green.

20 minutes by taxi / uber

### From Luton Airport 1.5 hours

Use the **Luton DART** transit system to get to **Luton Airport Parkway Station.** Catch an overground train for 4 stops to **Kings Cross St Pancras Station** (30 minutes). Change to the underground, take the **Piccadilly Line** (blue) west, 9 stops to South Kensington. Change to **District line** (green) and head west, 8 stops to Turnham Green.

1 hour by taxi / uber

### **From Stansted Airport** 2 hours

Catch the **Stansted Express** overground train to **Tottenham Hale.** Change to the underground, **Victoria Line** (light blue) south for 9 stops to Victoria Station. Change to the **District Line** (green) and head west to Ealing Broadway or Richmond (not Wimbledon). Turnham Green is 10 stops.

1.5 hours by taxi / uber.
